- Avoidance of wastages from RTCs involving haulage and freight services is essential


How Road Traffic Crashes Affects SMEs (2/2)

Way Forward - 1/4

Government to provide more motorable access roads to expand the existing road network to enhance trade involving door-to door services in Nigeria. This is critical for SME sustainability.



Way Forward - 2/4

The National Policy on SMEs, 2007, 2015 should be implemented in relation to its inter-connectivity with road transportation management, safety and security

Way Forward - 3/4

Enhance the RTSSS for improved Fleet Administration

The FRSC will continue to improve Road Transport Safety Standardization Scheme (RTSSS) to provide useful data to the NBS for planning and policy purposes.

Way Forward - 4/4

Eliminate compromise on the part of Security Agents on the road
